About the Show

Art On the Divide Cooperative Gallery invites local and regional artists to submit their artwork for the 4th Annual Invitational Art Exhibit, titled “*All Things Wild*” that will take place in September, 2017. This theme is open to your interpretation and therefore promises to be a very interesting show.

A committee of artists from the gallery will jury in the pieces. A “People’s Choice” award will be recognized by a ribbon at the end of the show.

Submission of Artwork

All mediums will be accepted. Art must be original design and for sale. Reproductions or giclees will not be accepted.

Two-dimensional artwork should be no larger than 24x36 inches. Three dimensional artwork is limited to 40lbs and a 2x2 foot maximum footprint. Gallery wrap is acceptable for oil, acrylic and photography. Artwork must be properly framed and wired for hanging as sawtooth hangers cannot be accepted. All sculpture or 3-d pieces must be free standing and stable.

Entry Fees and Deadlines

Early Bird Deadline is July 28th. 1st entry is \$10.00 and each additional is \$5.00 (up to 3 maximum).

Final Deadline is August 7th. 1st entry is \$20.00 and each additional is \$5.00 (up to 3 maximum)

Submission of Entry Form

Please submit Entry form and jpeg pictures of artwork at same time via email AODCgallery@gmail.com or USPS. It is preferable to submit as a jpeg attachment or submit a 4x6 photograph or jpeg file on CD. Photos and CD’s will be returned only upon request. **Send checks to: AODC Gallery P.O. Applicants will be notified by August 18th if their artwork has been selected. AODC Gallery will receive 20% commission on all sales during the show, please price your art accordingly. California sales tax will be added to all sales. All art considered for the show must be available for sale during the show.

Accepted artwork should be delivered to AODC Gallery, 6295 Main Street, Georgetown, on Aug. 26th or 27th between 11-4. Artists should pick up any unsold artwork on Oct. 2nd, between 10:00-12:00. Artwork must be displayed for the duration of the show. Arrangements need to be made ahead of time if someone other than the artist is to pick up or deliver art.

Artist Reception

AODC will host an artist reception on September 10th, 1-4. **Please save the date!**
